

Alternance codique : un marqueur d'une double appartenance socioculturelle et identitaire chez les jeunes issus de l'immigration algérienne en France

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Abstract: The present study aims to study the code-switching in the language practices of young people from Algerian immigrating to France. Our objective is to understand how these claim their socio-cultural identity through the use of a code-switching. How does the practice of code-switching explain their dual identity and socio-cultural identity? In order to achieve this goal, we have, on the one hand, performed a lexical analysis of a corpus of digital messages written by these young people, and, on the other, we conducted a questionnaire survey studying their representations. The results obtained showed that the code-switching helps young people from Algerian immigration not only to show their particularities but also to claim their dual socio-cultural and identity.
